### ON AN UNDIVIDED JERUSALEM

John McCain said, "Jerusalem is undivided, Jerusalem is the capital and we should move the [U.S.] embassy to Jerusalem." <sup>1</sup>	Hillary Clinton supports "an undivided Jerusalem" that "must never be questioned." <sup>2</sup>	Barack Obama flip-flopped on the issue, calling his initial support for an undivided Jerusalem a "poor phrasing" of words <sup>3</sup> and that the future of Jerusalem would have to be negotiated by Israel and the Palestinians. <sup>4</sup>
